Poverty is a particularly serious problem for children, who suffer the negative effects of living in need for the rest of their lives. Poor children experience increased rates of infant mortality, low birth weight, and health and developmental problems such as chronic disease. Impoverished children often have negative educational outcomes, with poor academic achievement and lower rates of high school graduation.

My foundation is looking to play a key role in ending poverty for young kids who are at risk and/or living in underserved communities. Our 10X Kids program focuses on financial literacy education that not only teaches an individual how to make money, but also how to invest that money in themselves. 10X Kids teaches our children to never settle for average, never lower their targets, and do whatever it takes to make their dreams a reality.

Our broad network of Community Partners has made our program available to at-risk youth across the country. These kids have developed key skills in entrepreneurship, sales, financial literacy, marketing, public speaking, communication, conflict resolution, time management, and relationship building. After seeing all of the success that our partners have had with this program, I know that the future of the Grant Cardone Foundation is extremely bright.

Our 2022 partnerships and programs have exceeded all expectations, and we can't wait to see how they continue to grow in 2023. In 2022 we introduced two new programs, the 10X Kids Pitch Off program, and the 10X Entrepreneurship program. The 10X Kids Pitch Off program will give select partners the opportunity to bring their students from all across the country to our office in Miami, to compete in a business pitch competition for seed money for their businesses. The 10X Entrepreneurship program will expand upon our 10X Kids program graduates who are interested in entrepreneurship, by providing a 10:1 dollar match, up to \$5,000.

On behalf of the Grant Cardone Foundation, I would like to personally thank our sponsors, partners, and donors, whose contributions allowed my team to expand upon our programming and develop new programs to support and uplift at-risk youth around the world. 

"For many years I lived in grief, anger, and resentment over the loss of my dad. I watched in envy and resentment of other kids spending time with their dads and it enraged me. I had become openly rebellious, a problem at school, my grades dropped to just above passing levels and I turned to drugs and alcohol. I had become an outcast in the school system and a black sheep of the family. At the age of 25, I started to turn my life around all because men stepped in to provide me with mentoring, direction, and purpose. I am so thankful to these men who took time with me, and I have used mentors for the last 35 years to continue my growth and development." - Grant Cardone

OUR IMPACT

10X HUB

The 10X Hub was officially launched in South Africa in 2021, in the townships of Paarl East and Mbekweni. The 10X Hub Program was created to provide financial literacy, education, entrepreneurial development, and mentorship programs to level the playing field and fight poverty in South Africa. The 10X Hub also serves as a mentorship hub for adolescents without fathers. South Africa has the highest population in the world of children growing up without a father. That absence of a father figure has proven to have a direct effect on economic welfare, production, erosion of human capital, social exclusion, crime, and social instability. The Grant Cardone Foundation and Grant Cardone are on a mission to close this disparity gap!

- Developed 718 new South African businesses
- Trained over 350,000 entrepreneurs
- Created over 1,000 jobs

10X KIDS

At the tail end of 2021, The Foundation launched the 10X Kids Program. This program is a culmination of all of Grant's real estate, marketing, investing, and entrepreneurial expertise, but adapted for kids ages 12-17. The program is made up of two resources: the *10X Kids* Book, and 10X Kids University. The *10X Kids* Book is based on Grant's runaway bestseller and #1 business education platform, the 10X Rule. 10X Kids University is an e-learning platform with narration, examples, interactions, and exercises designed to help kids create a strong foundation for financial literacy. Both resources are based on 5 core modules:



FIRST GENERATION SCHOLARSHIP

2022 was the second year of the Grant Cardone Foundation's FIU First Generation Scholarship. This full-ride scholarship (up to \$7,500 a year per student) is awarded each year to two Florida state residents who are incoming freshmen at FI, enrolled in any one of its four-year business programs. The first two scholarships were awarded at the start of the 2021 Fall semester, and the second two scholarships in the Fall semester of 2022. GCF will continue to provide the scholarship for these students for the remainder of their time at FIU (up to four years).





10X MENTORSHIP WORKSHOPS

Starting local is one of the best ways for GCF to reach their goal of impacting one million lives. The Foundation hosted 13 10X Mentorship workshops with 9 partners this year, at their headquarters in Aventura, Florida and at various community partner locations. Through partnerships, kids from at-risk and underserved communities across South Florida were brought in to discuss an array of crucial topics. With their attendance, GCF partners saw an immediate impact on these kids' attitude, motivation, and attentiveness. The Grant Cardone Foundation will continue these valuable workshops in order to change the narrative of poverty within underserved neighborhoods.



10X PITCH OFF CONTEST

In August of 2022, the Grant Cardone Foundation kicked off its first 10X Pitch Off Contest with entrepreneurial high school students from Tumaini DC, a nonprofit organization located in Washington, DC. Tumaini DC incorporated the 10X Kids curriculum into their 6-week entrepreneurship program, where they worked with over 30 students to create a sound business model. Tumaini and their entrepreneurial students participated in this pitch off contest, presented in front of our judges (Mrs. Elena Cardone, Ms. Stormy Wellington, Mrs. Sheri Hamilton and Mr. Jarrod Glandt), and received great feedback on how to elevate their business model. In 2023, the Grant Cardone Foundation will continue to provide this opportunity to select school students with additional Community Partners throughout the United States.

BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS SCHOOL TO WORK

The Grant Cardone Foundation is a champion in providing mentorship to atrisk youth. One way they do this is through their partner, Big Brothers, Big Sisters of Broward County. For the 2022-2023 school year, 20 Hallandale High School juniors and seniors will receive one-to-one mentoring support from their Big Brother or Big Sister employed at Grant Cardone Enterprises and The Grant Cardone Foundation. These interactions are critical to social and emotional development, help build resilience, and promote the wellbeing of these fantastic students.

IMPACT MAP



2022 SOURCES OF REVENUE



The Grant Cardone Foundation has seen such a tremendous amount of talented youth in our ecosystem of Community partners that it felt right to honor a youth who showcases determination, ambition, and passion. GCF is honored to select Ms. Magdalena Gonzalez as our 2022 10X Kid of the Year. Magdalena, through our partner Take Stock in Children, completed our 10X Kids University curriculum and reinforced her goals through the teachings of our program. Please take a moment to read Magdalena's personal growth with our 10X Kids program and her story.

Why does this student deserve to win 10X Kid of the Year?

Magdalena came to this land of opportunity from Spain after she and her family escaped an oppressive Cuban regime when she was four years old. Since she reached America with her family, her life has been the picture of a kid who has applied maximum effort to every goal to reach her dreams. She quickly learned the language and thrived in school. She also learned how to use her language acquisition and technology skills to help her family establish their business technology to promote business models and marketing sites. She is an example of a kid who has overcome adversity and has used that energy for her success and the success of her family. She has extended that effort to her community as she has volunteered over 270 hours at the YMCA as a lifeguard and teaching swim lessons. As a result of her commitment to water safety for children, she was offered a job at the YMCA where she now works as she completes her education.

Magdalena is approaching the end of her senior year with a plan to graduate from John I Leonard High School in Palm Beach County with an AICE Diploma, receiving the Florida Academic Scholars Award through the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program. She will also be graduating from Palm Beach State College with her Associates of Arts diploma. She wants to pursue a career in Digital Marketing as well as develop and run an ocean conservation nonprofit. Her academic success makes her a good candidate for the University of Florida where she hopes to enroll in its business program. She deserves to be a 10X Kid of the Year because she is already demonstrating the qualities and successes of a 10X mindset in her personal, academic, and work life. She has the drive and the skill set to see her dreams become a reality, and the compassion and foresight to make sure she does not succeed alone.

What does 10X mean to this student?

Magdalena says that 10X means going as far as you can, no matter what is holding you back. You can't let any obstacle impede your advance or make you think small and limited. You look at your possibilities and assess what you can change to apply maximum effort to achieve your goals and dreams. Whatever it is, you get it done.

How has the 10X Kids Program impacted this student?

NAGORIER DE LA CONSTRUCTION DE L Magdalena says that the 10X Program has fortified her dreams and opened her mind to ideas about what is possible. In addition to wanting a career as a Digital Marketing Specialist, she has a dream to start an ocean conservation nonprofit. The 10X course helped her to think how that can happen sooner and with greater impact for the oceans, and to reach her goals. She realized the value of positioning herself within circles of leadership to make the connections that will enable her to contribute and benefit from relationships at school and work. She says she was always active in clubs and organizations and now she realizes that those decisions were aligned with the 10X mindset.
